




I have no water or low pressure at my home or lot.

1st Steps

- Inspect your home, crawl space and property for water leaks and/or faulty components (outside bibs, yard hydrants, hoses, sprinklers, etc).
- Check your main water valve to ensure the valve is on and fully open.
- If installed, check your pressure regulator valve (PRV) for proper operation.
- If installed, check your water heater, water softener and water filtration system for proper operation and to ensure all valves are in the proper position.
- Check your water pressure (40psi or above is acceptable).



Report the issue as there may be a problem in our distribution system:

Note: MS HOA is responsible for the repair and cost of all components in the water distribution system up to and including the water meters. The lot owner is responsible for the repair and cost of all components from the water meter onto their lot - all are private property.

The cost of any repairs required on private property will be the responsibility of the lot owner. Any payments for such repairs made by the HOA on behalf of the lot owner must be promptly reimbursed to the HOA.

Make your repair(s) promptly. Leaks can be damaging and costly and should be addressed as soon as possible.
